

# Hawk Crest Farm

## Mare Breeding Contract

This agreement is made between \_\_\_\_\_, foal purchaser(s), residing at \_\_\_\_\_, and Vaughn or Valerie Wilson, mare owners and seller of the foal, located at 37 Henry Burns Lane, Petal MS, 39465.

### **BREEDING AGREEMENT:**

The foal purchaser(s) agree to send cool shipped semen from the stallion at no cost to the Wilsons in order to inseminate their mare, \_\_\_\_\_. Breeding services will be coordinated between the Wilsons and the collector/shipper of the cooled semen. If the mare does not conceive, or more semen is required for any reasons, the foal purchaser will attempt to send fresh cooled semen up to three times (or more if they so choose). After the third attempt the foal purchaser(s) may choose to discontinue breeding efforts, thus causing this contract to be null and void.

### **VET EXPENSES AND FOALING:**

The foal purchaser(s) will be responsible for veterinarian **breeding expenses** for both the stallion and the mare. These expenses will include, but not be limited to, semen collection and testing, mare cultures, sonograms, and foal exams. The foal purchaser will be fully responsible for all veterinary expenses for the foal, once conceived. Before veterinary services are rendered, the Wilsons are required to contact the foal purchaser(s) for approval of such services for the foal and mare unless a medical emergency is present and quick decision-making is needed. In case of an emergency regarding the foal, the purchaser will allow immediate care not to exceed \$ \_\_\_\_\_. In order to exceed the \$ \_\_\_\_\_ limit, the foal purchaser(s) must be contacted and notified of the situation and approval must be given directly from the foal purchaser(s).

If the mare suffers any condition requiring veterinary attention not related directly to the breeding or delivery of the foal such as, but not limited to, pasture injury, colic, trailer injury, etc., the Wilsons will assume responsibility for those veterinary expenses. If during delivery, the mare is under distress or requires a

veterinarian during delivery, the Wilsons will be responsible for the cost associated with the birth and the mare's well being.

The Wilsons are providing a LIVE FOAL GUARANTEE. If for any reason, the foal is born dead or is deceased within the first 72 hours of birth, due to birth complications, the Wilsons will waive the pre purchase price and the contract will be null and void. However, if this situation arises, the foal purchaser(s) are NOT able to recover any monies spent in the breeding such as, but not limited to, stallion fees, collection, and shipping fees. If the foal is born with complications that result in the foal being deformed or having medical complications, the Wilsons and the foal purchaser(s) agree to negotiate and compromise to determine a fair outcome for both parties in regards to a price deduction and/or doing what is best for the foal.

**PREAGREED PURCHASE PRICE:**

The Wilsons and the foal purchaser(s) have agreed on a pre purchase price of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for the foal resulting from the breeding of the stallion \_\_\_\_\_ and the mare \_\_\_\_\_ . A deposit of **\$500.00** is required at the signing of this agreement and the balance of \$\_\_\_\_\_ is to paid prior to the foal leaving Hawk Crest Farm.

**INSURANCE:**

It is highly recommended that the foal purchaser invests in medical and mortality equine insurance for the foal. If insurance is purchased, the Wilsons are required to follow the insurers protocol for reporting injury or death of the foal.

**FOAL REGISTRATION:**

The Wilsons agree to sign a bill of sale for the foal and provide properly signed registration documents to the foal purchaser(s) once the foal has been paid for in full.

**FOAL TRANSFER**

The resulting foal will remain with the dam for a minimum of 4 months and a maximum of 8 months. The foal purchaser(s) will be responsible for transportation arrangements and costs involved in transferring the foal to their property. Following the foal's weaning from its dam, the purchaser(s) will be responsible for all foal care including, but not limited to, feed, deworming, vaccinations, and hoof maintenance while the foal remains at Hawk Crest Farm.

**PARTY DEFAULT:**

Should either party default on this contract, the defaulting party will be entitled to pay the other party any and all expenses incurred as a result of the default. If both parties agree to terminate this contract, a letter must be written and signed by both parties to show and conclude the termination.
